PETITION FOR DECREE OF DIVORCE

In the Court of District Judge, at

A.....Petitioner.

Versus.

B..... Respondent.

(Petition for Decree of Divorce under section 13(1)(a) of Hindu Marriage Act)

The petitioner submits as under:

1. That marriage of the petitioner and the respondent was solemnized onat according to Hindu rites and ceremonies. Marriage stands registered with the 'Registrar of Marriages. Certified copy of extract from the concerned register is enclosed herewith.

Status and place of residence of the parties to the marriage before the marriage and at the time of filing of this petition is given as under:

7. This petition is being presented without any unnecessary or improper delay on the part of the petitioner.
8. There is no other legal ground as to why the decree prayed for should not be granted in favour of the petitioner.
9. No litigation has taken place between the parties to the petition earlier (state, if any, previous litigation with regard to the marriage came to be initiated by any party. Also give details of the petitions or the cases so instituted earlier).
10. This Hon'ble Court has jurisdiction to 'entertain and try this petition as the marriage was solemnized at or the parties last resided together at and even presently the respondent is residing within the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court.
11. The petitioner therefore prays for grant of decree for divorce in his favour and against the respondent.
